- Record meetings for future viewing and provide recorded meetings that retain the rich functionality of a live meeting.

- Enable high-quality video conferencing, allow live video feeds from participants, and (in on-premise deployments) stream video directly into meetings using SIP-compliant video conferencing hardware.
- Create, monitor, and manage multiple breakout rooms to focus discussions.
- Provide greater meeting accessibility for all attendees with complete keyboard navigation, screen reader support, hot keys, and closed-captioning extensions.

Manage meetings and content more effectively

With Adobe Connect, hosts have full control before and during the meeting over meeting room layout and appearance; meeting room persistence; participant roles and privileges; and content creation, storage, and access. They also have the ability to archive meetings and edit the recordings for anytime viewing. Advantages of Adobe Connect include the ability to:

- Use online content libraries to more securely store and manage rich media content.
- Collaborate behind the scenes in real time with other presenters.
- Use the new optional Adobe Connect desktop Adobe AIR® client to more easily set up, manage, and attend meetings.

- Comply with government regulations and internal policies by safeguarding, storing, and tracking electronic communications within Adobe Connect.
- Pre-define a list of applications which cannot be shared with meeting participants in-meeting or on recordings.
