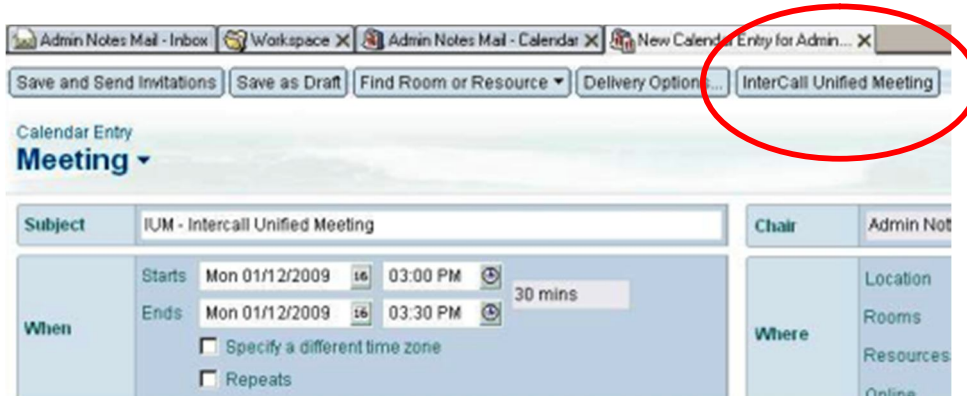
To add these features to your account now, simply download the application from www.intercall.com/iumgo (or www.intercall.ca/iumgo for Canadian customers.)

Below you will find a brief description of the features now available so you can see for yourself what's new.



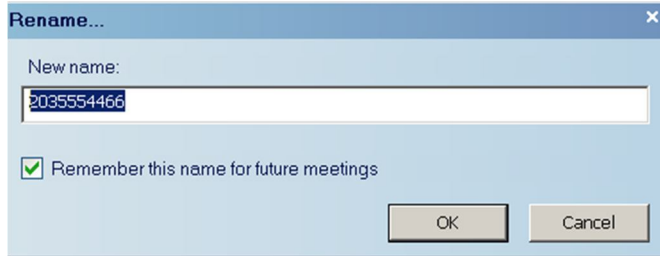
Lotus Notes Calendar Local Plug-In

Scheduling meetings using Lotus Notes is now easier than ever! Moderators that utilize Lotus Notes can now take advantage of the scheduling tool without requiring an update to their company's Domino server email template. Lotus Notes users can now install a scheduling plug-in directly to their computer along with the meeting application



Participant Number Identification

This new feature adds an additional layer of security to your meeting and makes it even easier for moderators to manage audio participants online.



Upon joining a meeting, the Participant Number Identification feature looks up the participant's dial-in number and automatically checks it against the moderator's Outlook Personal Address Book. If the name is not found, the moderator can right-click the participant audio line and rename it.

The participant name is then shown for the current conference and will automatically display for any future meetings.

Name Replay

Name Replay has been added to the existing list of options that grant moderators greater control over their meetings. When a moderator right clicks on a participant's line in the Participant panel their recorded name will be replayed.

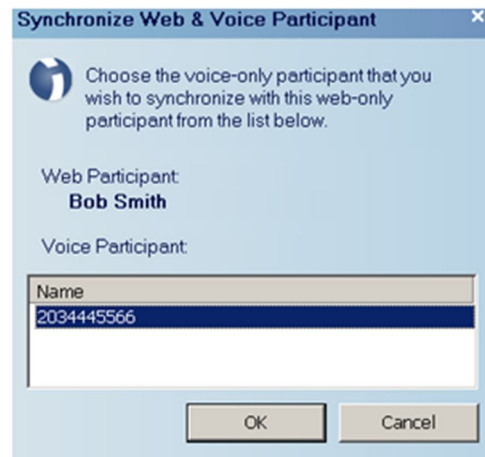
Note: The Name Record setting must be enabled prior to the meeting on the Reservationless-Plus® audio platform.

New Participant Features

The following updates help simplify the meeting experience for participants when they join an InterCall Unified Meeting.

Online Web and Audio Synchronization

Participants can now synchronize their own audio and web connections via the web interface instead of pressing audio DTMF commands into a telephone keypad.





Participant dial me enhancements

Participants can now select previously dialed numbers from a drop down when joining a meeting. This eliminates the need to re-enter any commonly used numbers for each meeting which in turn makes joining a meeting even faster!

Korean Language Support

Korean language support has been added to our already robust offering of languages. This support is available for both participants and moderators.

Video Tutorials

Take advantage of our free video tutorials! When you complete the installation of the meeting application you are automatically provided with a video tutorial that walks you through the InterCall Unified Meeting experience. A catalog of additional videos is accessible from the Help menu of the moderator's user interface.

Enhanced Microsoft Support

InterCall Unified Meeting now fully supports Microsoft Internet Explorer 9.0. In addition, you can now schedule meetings with the Outlook plug-in and show content in a meeting using Microsoft Office 64-bit configuration.
